SUPPLIES YOU MUST FURNISH

You are responsible for furnishing the following:

1. All grills, stoves, or any other cooking equipment.
2. All serving and cooking utensils, including tongs and spatulas and tables needed for food preparation.
3. A tent or canopy.
4. Lights so you can see under canopy or tent.
5. Water container (water is available near your booth).
6. Extension cords (**Note: All electrical hook-ups require an additional fee of \$25.**)
 - a. Outlets will be a maximum of 100 feet from your booth
 - b. You will have the use of one 110V outlet
 - c. If electrical hook-ups other than 110V are needed, prior arrangements must be made with either Dara Broomfield 863.683.0795(Professional) or Lori Holmes 863.802.8265 (Backyard).
